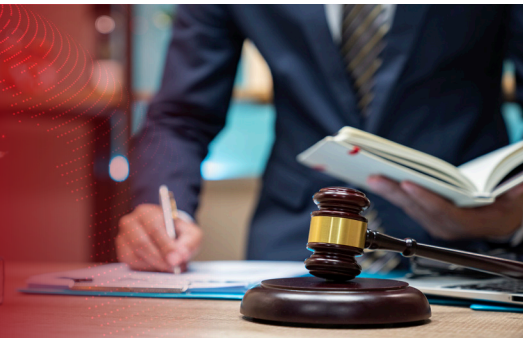


## The Legal War Room
