Job Accounting II is a cost management tool that tracks and manages print and scan jobs. It lets you know who is printing and what is being printed. Job Accounting II can help to track print activities such as color, mono and duplex, and set print limits and settings by user or department. Help your customers manage their printing costs and bring in additional revenue opportunities with Job Accounting II.

Job Accounting II helps to authenticate, authorize and account.



Authenticate: Enable Job Accounting II and control user access with an easy-to-use login using the network username and password, proximity card or pin code.



Authorize: Cost management with accurate accounts of print, copy and scan activities to help increase efficiencies and reduce waste.



Account: Optimize resources by monitoring activities such as print/copy/scan to help minimize waste and printing costs and set limits by users or department.



Track: Manage print jobs to Sharp and select non-Sharp devices with a secured print release option.

Manage MFP activities and feature access control for users and departments to enhance a secured environment.

Monitor and centralize access control of MFPs by users or by department.

Cost Recovery by billing clients back using client matter*.

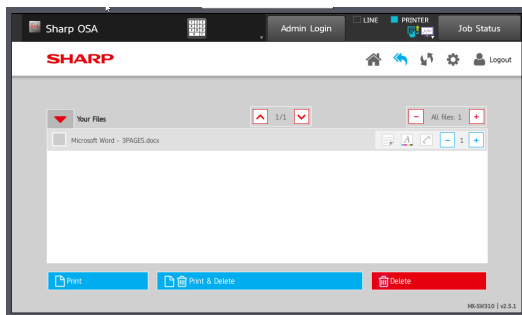
Secure print/copy/scan activities and allows user flexibility by enabling print release from any network connected MFPs*.

Rules Based Printing: Allows organizations to implement print rules and enforce mono, duplex, page count and reroute jobs.

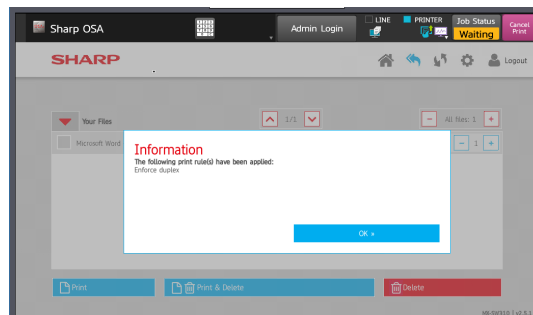
Customize Reports: Enhanced reporting now offers flexibility to select the data fields to include in a report.

MFP Panel: Pull print queue with finishing options.

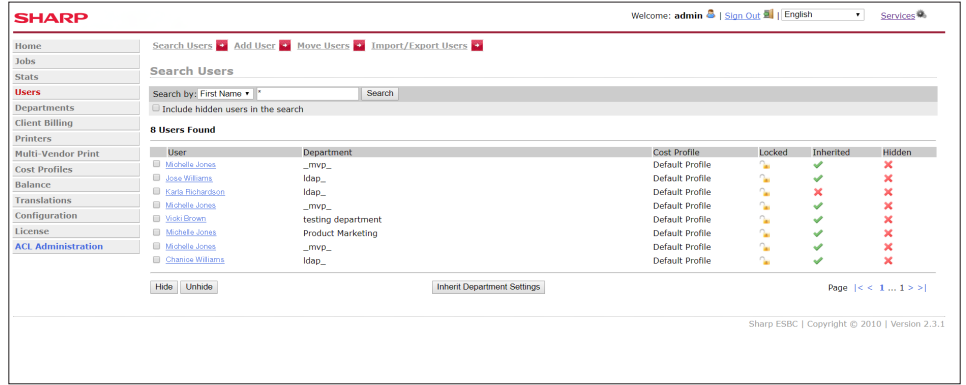


MFP Panel: Duplex print rule modification for users.

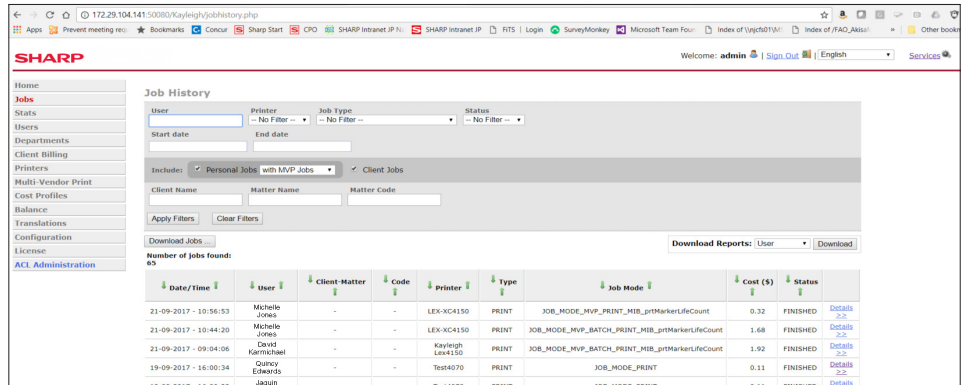
