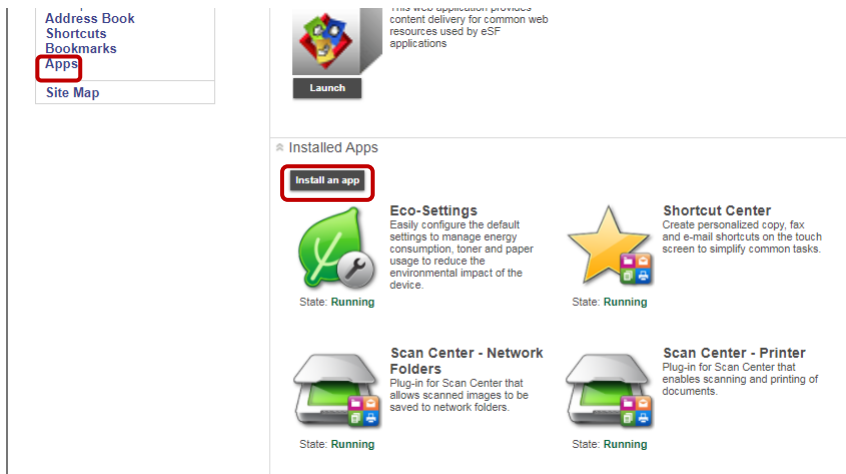
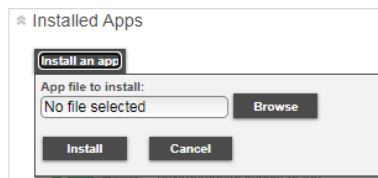


How to Install (Cloud Connector) 1/2

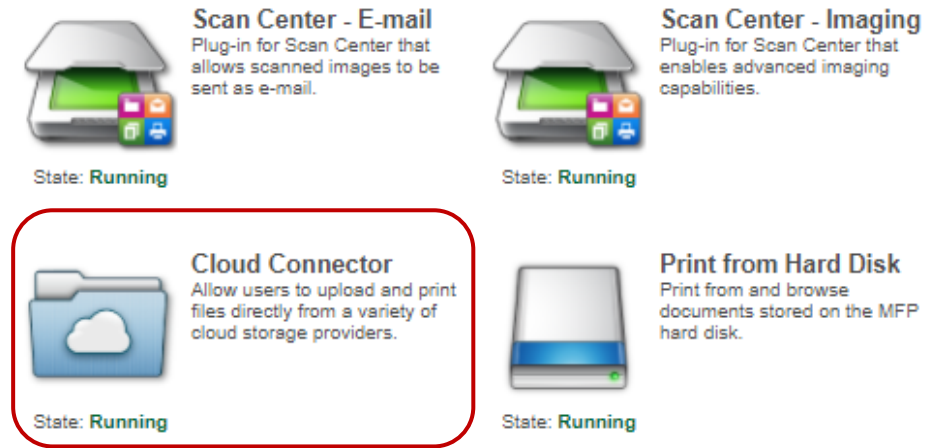
1. Download the Apps and store your PC.
2. Open a web browser, type machine IP address in the address field.
3. Click “Apps”, and “Install an app”.



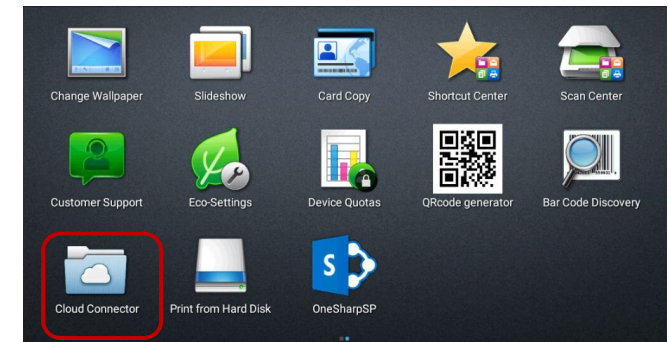
4. Click “Browse”, and select “cca_main_XXXXX.flx” file then install.



- 5-1. When installation succeeds, the “Cloud Connector” icon automatically appears on the EWS.

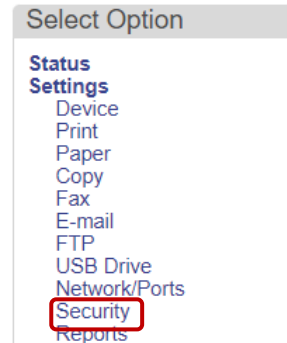


- 5-2. “Cloud Connector” icon automatically appears on the operation panel.

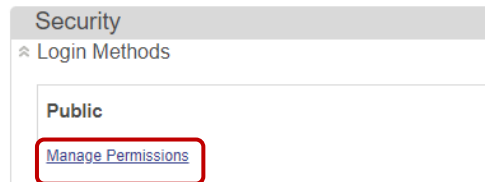


How to Install (Cloud Connector) 2/2

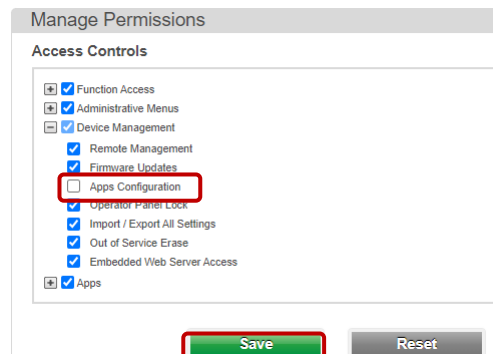
6. Click “Security”.



7. Click “Manage Permission” on the Public.



8. Remove checkmark from “Apps Configuration” and then click “Save”.



Note 1: To use Cloud Connector, administrator has to update the firmware (Ver 081.215 or later).
Note 2: Disabling the “Apps Configuration” setting will also disable installation and access of the eSF applications’ configuration page. Please make sure to use admin accounts.

Users can scan/print the data from/to the MFP to/from the specified cloud service.**

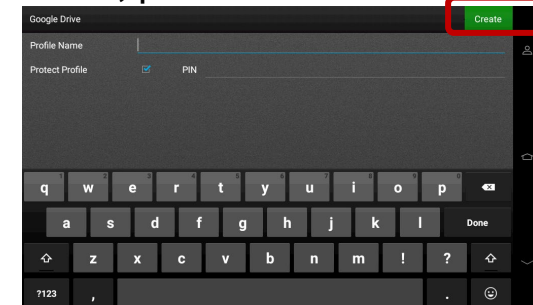
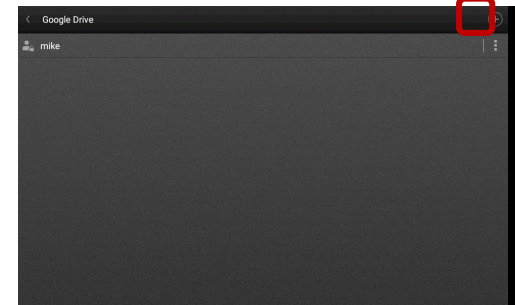
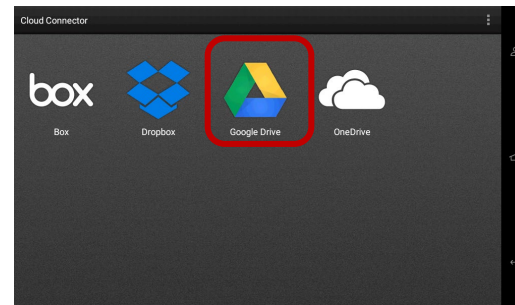
The supported Cloud is as follows.

The supported format for Scan to Cloud: TIFF, JPEG, PDF, XPS, TXT, RTF, DOCX, CSV

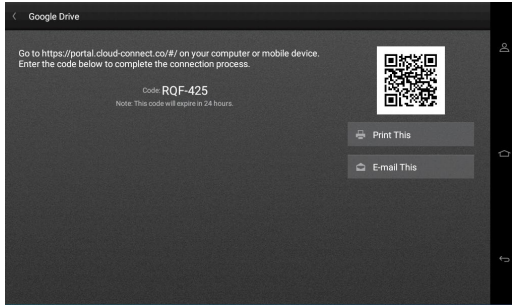
Before access to the Cloud service, users have to create their profile.

1. Click Cloud Connector icon.
2. Click Cloud icon you want to access.
3. Click + to create profile.
4. Enter Profile Name and PIN.
Then, press “Create”.

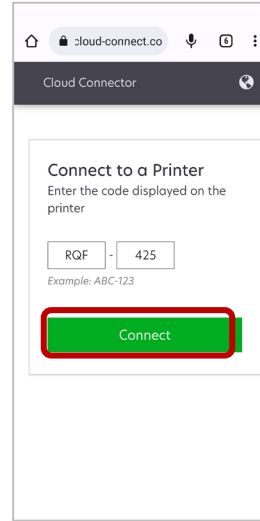

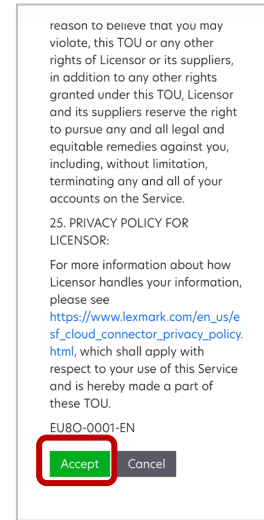
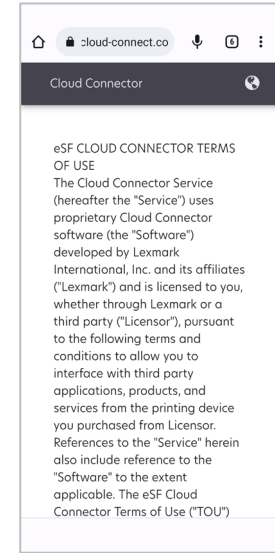
5. After creating the profile, the following screen appears on the MFP.



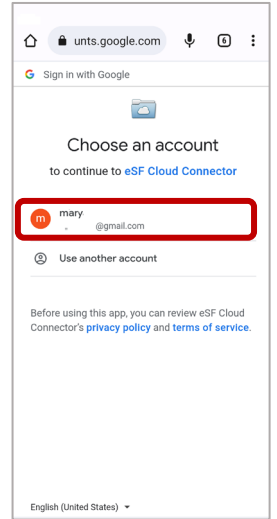
6. Reading QR code, or typing <https://portal.cloud-connect.co> And then enter code, click “Connect”.



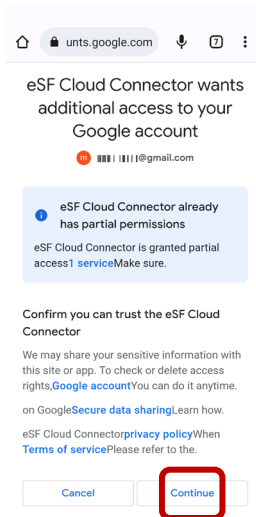
7. Terms of Use appears. Click “Accept”.



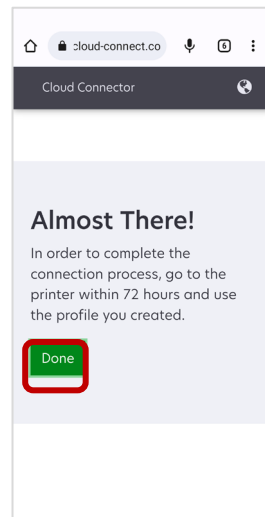
8. Choose an account to access.
